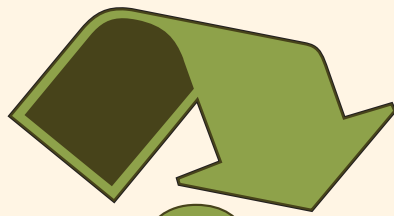

INTENDED USES

Can be used on interior surfaces, such as walls walls and ceilings. Not intended for high traffic areas such as trim, doors, cabinets, floors or exterior surfaces that require high performance coatings.

SUBSTRATES

Plaster, drywall, primed wood

FINISH

The finish varies from batch to batch and from colour to colour. Can be described as a 'Satin' finish, which is higher than traditional 'Eggshell' and lower than a traditional 'Semi-Gloss' finishes.

SURFACE PREPARATION

Can be applied to a variety of properly prepared interior substrates including wood, drywall, concrete block or stucco. Surfaces to be painted must be clean, dry and free of mildew, loose or scaling paint and other contaminants. Glossy surfaces must be sanded with 120 grit sandpaper. Substrates subject to stain bleed should be primed with a stain blocking primer. Lightly sand between coats.

DRY TIME

At 25C, 50% Relative Humidity: To Touch: 45 min., To RE-coat: 4 hrs. Cooler temperatures, higher humidity or excess film build will extend dry times.

THINNING

Not normally required. Thin with 10% clean water for spray applications.

SPREAD / COVERAGE

250- 400 ft²/gal (5.0 - 9.0 m²/L)

APPLICATION TOOLS & TECHNIQUES

Brush, roll or spray. Airless tip sizes: .0013" - 0.017"

LIMITATIONS

Due to the nature of the recycling process, the paint is accepted as an 'as is' condition, which means that the paint found in the containers can be of good quality, as it contains paint of all quality levels and has been filtered during processing to rid of as many impurities as possible.

ReCoat™ is a 100% recycled interior latex paint product mixed from a combination of 100% post-consumer paint with various acrylics and vinyl interior and exterior quality paints. So, depending upon the specific batch of recycled paint, the material in the container can be of good quality. ReCoat™ paint has been filtered for as many impurities as possible during processing to ensure a consistent paint within each batch and is provided in an 'as is' condition.

Due the mix of recycled post-consumer paint, the paint has a heavy body providing good coverage and will hide usually in one or two coats. The nature of recycled paint cannot guarantee an exact colour or sheen match from batch to batch, so obtain enough paint from the same batch for each project. Touch-ups may not blend in so re-painting the wall section may be necessary. Some colours require further coats.
